It is a privilege to have you with us, committed to the extension of the Kingdom of God to the nations.

Missions Report on Outreach to the Lenca

During the last few months, we have experienced God's faithfulness in every step of the ministry. We are grateful for your support.

We have been able to make progress in the following projects and activities:

- **Evangelism in Lenca communities:** We have carried out several evangelistic activities in 15 villages where the message of the gospel had not yet been heard. This photograph is from the community of Llano Largo, where a new church is being started. There is an average of 20 conversions per month in all the communities.

- **Discipleship and Training:** We are mentoring several Bible study groups, primarily for believers who want to go out and evangelize and make new disciples, who are growing in their faith and commitment. In the city, we have nine people who attend regularly and show great enthusiasm for learning and serving.



These training sessions are also being held in San Nicolás, El Naranjito, and Cacahuatal, where we have had excellent results and more people attending the discipleship programs. The photo

- **Solar Panel Project for Remote Churches:** It has been a great blessing to see this light shine in the darkness. Churches with electricity can carry out various activities, especially their services, where they can preach the gospel at night.

- **Social Assistance:** Lenca women were trained in making pine baskets. The goal is to develop skills that will help them

provide food for their families.





- Leadership Training: We held the Lenca pastors' conference and retreat, "United We Are Better," to foster fellowship and discuss the importance of uniting in mission and supporting newer, more established churches. It was a beautiful time of fellowship and spiritual strength to continue the work in the mountains.

Challenges and Opportunities

We have 42 Lenca leaders and pastors. We must train them diligently to win many souls for Christ. This coming year, we want to reinforce the fundamentals, especially salvation by grace and the life of our Lord Jesus. We must work hard on our work with children and youth, as we face challenges in many villages.
