

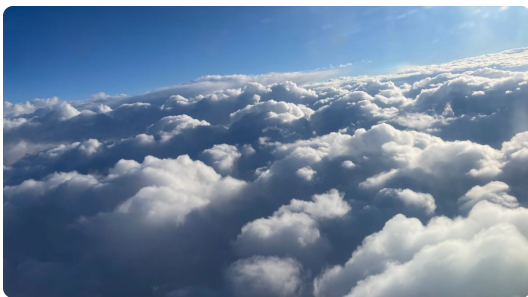
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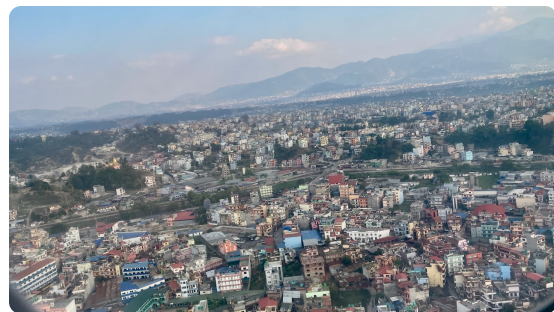


Brief Glimpses on Westward Trip

We worked to help people that are already doing some teaching or training so they could learn how to be more effective in teaching and using adult learning principles.

Practicing these techniques, was a big part of the time together.

It definitely took a lot of work the first day as we got to know each other and as participants adjusted to a very different approaches than the more normal lecturing mode. But it was so fun to see them really start to open up and get excited about the possibilities of improving their own efforts in their Bodies or trainings. We had really good feedback and positive commitment to work harder to apply some of the principles learned. The biggest complaint was that it wasn't long enough!

We look to Him to use this in the lives of the 14 participants in a way that will further equip them to minister and expand in their own Bodies.



The time has come, and I leave to move to Chiang Mai, Thailand on an overnight flight the 26th. The current plan is to come back here early in November. Things are in process for a Retirement visa, with a lot of logistics remaining to make that happen.
