FOOD DONATION FOR LENCA FAMILIES

We received a donation of food for Lenca families: 800 boxes of food to be distributed in Lenca communities. This was a great blessing and a way to contribute to these households with food and also with evangelism.



COMPLETION OF CLASSROOMS FOR CHILDREN AT THE CITY CHURCH

With the collaboration of several brothers and sisters from the local church and a sister mission, the construction of the children's classrooms for our church in the city has been completed. This is a great blessing for our children who attend church every Sunday and also serves us for discipleship training.



LENCA BIBLE INSTITUTE AND NEW PROGRAMS ARE COMING

Our pastor and leader training project is progressing very well. In the photograph, we can see the brothers and sisters from the Marcala region receiving their basic doctrine classes. This is a very important region, as there are several communities that will be impacted by the Word of God and the gospel in this area, since many do not have churches or are just starting them. They receive classes every Saturday. We also have these Bible training groups in other areas. We have recently formed an alliance with the Nogales Baptist Seminary, a highly recognized institution, which will be certifying the students.



CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CHURCH IN THE COMMUNITY OF LLANO LARGO

A new church has been built in the community of Llano Largo. This new building will be a great blessing to the



brothers and sisters in Christ in this area. The construction is beautiful. It will be overseen by Pastor Antonio Escobar, who is training a local leader, Brother Walter.

LENCA WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Yoamy and her team of leaders continue working with discipleship and encouraging Lenca women, and they make monthly visits to the main communities. The Lenca women travel from their communities to the meeting place, where they are encouraged with the Word of God and fellowship. 47

women attended this month's meeting in the community of El Naranjito Opalaca.



MY FAMILY

We have been going through a difficult time with illness. Our daughter Ruth

became ill with an infection that ended up being a kidney problem caused by a ureteral obstruction. We had to perform a series of tests and, ultimately, internal microscopic surgery to clear the passage in the ureter. Now she is doing well and recovering, but she had to put her university studies on hold. The doctor has told us that everything points to her making a full recovery.

Yoamy also faced a severe drop in her hemoglobin to the point that she almost needed a transfusion. But with medical intervention and medication, she recovered quickly. She has also used some indigenous medicines that have worked excellently for her full recovery. We have no doubt that your prayers have made a difference in our lives and ministry.

- 1) Pray for the summer support groups that will be helping us in June and August.
- 2) Pray for the Lenca youth. We are organizing them right now, and we are planning a camp for October.
- 3) Pray for Ruth's studies. After undergoing surgery, she will be returning to university in Honduras. Her classes begin in July. She was attending North Carolina last semester, but it will no longer be possible for her. Her son David will also be starting his university studies, possibly in the science. Please pray for them.
