

THE JACKS' JOURNEY WITH ETHNOS360 – JULY 2026

Greetings from Ethnos360 Bible Institute in Wisconsin! On May 20th, we celebrated with 90 Bible school graduates (including some from the online program). 30 grew up in other countries where their parents are missionaries. 58% indicate they plan to use their schooling in full-time missions (most with Ethnos360; 7% with other mission organizations). Accreditation is finally a reality, and a new scholarship fund has been set up to assist deserving students with the cost of missionary training. These are huge answers to prayer that you have been a part of!

As enrollment nears max capacity (250 in-person students), we are thankful the school was able to buy several fourplexes on the edge of campus. Ken has been working hard this summer installing nine pallets of laminate flooring, among other things! This will provide a long-term solution to intern housing; previously interns were housed in vacant student housing.

In April, we took 19 students on a Spring Break trip to a tribal missions exposure campus in Pennsylvania. It was staffed by missionaries with successful church-planting experiences in remote language groups of Brazil and Papua New Guinea. All Ethnos360 missionaries, including ourselves, raise our own support for salary and ministry expenses. We have a great team behind us but rising costs (and a couple supporters needing to retire) have us back down to 50% of recommended levels. We are blessed to be able to supplement with side jobs that give us connections in the community, but are asking the Lord for several more donors at \$50/mo. to keep from getting stretched too thin.
